

# How Do I Get There?

## How Do I Get To McCormick Place?

- 1. Drive your car North on Lake Shore Drive, get off at 31st St. and go West to Martin Luther King Drive and turn right and go North to McCormick Place.**
- 2. Walk two blocks South on Cornell (next to the BP gas station) and take the Metra Train for a few dollars to inside McCormick Place (a 5 minute train ride).**
- 3. Take a Taxi out front. Approximate cost \$18.00 one way.**

## How Do I get To Downtown?

- 1. Take our shuttle leaving at 9:30 am, 11:30am, 2:30pm and 6:30 pm. (Limited capacity and not a guaranteed service.)**
- 2. Walk two blocks South on Cornell (next to the BP gas station) and take the Metra Train on a 10 minute ride to downtown and Millennium Park/Grant Park & Museum Campus (cost approx \$3.00 one way).**
- 3. Walk two blocks South on Cornell to the #6 bus and take it to downtown Chicago. Travels up Lake Shore Drive and Michigan Ave to Wacker Drive and then comes back on State Street. Approx cost \$2.25 one way and runs every 10-15 minutes.**

## How Do I get to The Museum of Science & Industry?

- 1. Take our shuttle departing at 8:30am, 1:30pm & 5:30pm. (Limited capacity and not a guaranteed service.)**
- 2. Walk two blocks South on Cornell and take the # 6 bus South to the Museum Approx cost \$2.25 one way. Runs every 10-15 minutes.**

## How Do I get to The University of Chicago?

- 1. Walk two blocks South on Cornell (next to the BP gas station) and take the # 172 bus to the University. Approx cost \$2.25 one way. Runs every 10-15 minutes.**
- 2. Take our shuttle departing at 8:30am, 1:30pm & 5:30pm. (Limited capacity and not a guaranteed service.)**
